



COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON EVENTS: Community Event at TopGolf | March 27, 2022

The Virginia Hemophilia Foundation (VHF) asks that all in-person event attendees be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in the effort to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Please consider that many of our members face unique health challenges. VHF will not require that any attendees submit proof of vaccination but will rely on the honor system.

Attendees (ages 5 and up) must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Full vaccination is defined as:

- 2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose vaccine series (Pfizer or Moderna)
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson's/Janssen vaccine)
- The second dose of Pfizer/Moderna or single dose of Johnson & Johnson's/Janssen **must be received on or before March 12, 2022, to attend the Community Event at TopGolf.**

VHF recommends that attendees follow CDC guidelines for getting booster shots, if and when they are eligible. Boosters are recommended at least 5 months after the second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccination and at least 2 months after the single dose of Johnson & Johnson's/Janssen vaccination.

Wearing a protective mask is required for attendees (ages 2 and up). Masks must cover both nose and mouth throughout the event unless you are eating or drinking. Surgical masks will be provided on site. Surgical, N95, and KN95 masks are strongly preferred. Well-fitting cloth masks are acceptable. Gaiters, bandanas, and masks with exhalation valves will not be accepted.

Attendance Precautions

Do not plan to attend the community event if:

- You are sick.
- You have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 10 days.
- You tested positive for COVID-19 and haven't ended isolation (even if you are fully vaccinated).
- You are waiting for results of a COVID-19 test.

VHF Event Cancellation Policy

We have a no-questions-asked cancellation policy. Whether you experience a bleed right before traveling or have been exposed to COVID-19, we understand that emergency and illness are out of your control. We ask that you remember to cancel your registration ASAP so that VHF does not incur any extra costs in paying for no-shows or late cancellations.
